A total of _____ steps (grace upon grace)

Note: As one moves upward, the width becomes increasingly _____.

40:48 ~ vestibule - _____ cubits = 24.5 ft. (a small passageway or room leading to another)

41:2 ~ nave – _____ cubits = 17.5 ft. (central part of the Temple; entrance)

41:3 ~ holy place ~ _____ cubits = 10.5 ft.

Note: Ezekiel is allowed to be where the outer court is measured but is _____ allowed into the most holy place – the inner sanctuary (v. 3).

Note the Temple, courtyard, and wall dimensions.
