As March started our forty-day contemplation of the Journey to the Cross, April finds its fulfillment.

Rejoicing with palms. A sacred meal in the Upper Room. A garden of prayer and great drops of blood. A brutal death. A kind and gracious burial. A glorious resurrection. All within the span of two weeks. Hope. Despair. Hope.

I often feel like I'm in that same pattern post-cross: Hope. Despair. Hope. Hope in the final victory of Jesus over death. Despair in still being in this broken world with broken bodies and broken minds. Hope in the Appearing. Hope in the trumpet blast and the shout of an archangel. Hope in the dead rising first and my joining them on the way up - to be with our Lord and Savior forever more.

It reminds me of Silent Saturday. The day between Good Friday and Resurrection Sunday. Hope deferred makes the heart sick, but a longing fulfilled is a tree of life (Prov. 113:12). There is a lot of waiting in April and May.

My prayer is that in the waiting we may not miss the beautiful details that fill in the gaps. They, too, are an important part of the story...His story...our story.
