PHYSICAL EXPRESSION OF WORSHIP by Cindy Heinzman

Have you ever wondered why people raise their hands, clap, shout and sing in church? If you're anything like me, there have been moments in my life when I've asked the question "what are we doing and why?" The Bible includes various physical expressions of worship that reflect reverence, devotion and praise to God. Here are some examples:

- I. Lifting hands: In Psalm 63:4 David expresses worship by lifting his hands to God. This act symbolizes surrender and openness to God's presence
- 2. Kneeling and Bowing: Kneeling is a common posture in worship, as seen in Psalm 95:6, where it says "Come, let us bow down in worship, let us kneel before the Lord our Maker"
- 3. Dancing: Exodus 15:20-21 "And Miriam the prophetess, the sister of Aaron, took a timbrel in her hand; and all the women went out after her with timbrels and with dances. And Miriam answered them, Sing ye to the Lord, for he hath triumphed gloriously; the horse and his rider hath he thrown into the sea." This shows that joyful movement can be a form of worship
- 4. Clapping and shouting: Psalm 47:1 "Clap your hands, all you nations; shout to God with cries of joy". The Psalmist encourages clapping and shouting for joy to God.
- 5. Prostration: In Revelation 7:11, the angels fall on their faces before the throne of God, which signifies deep reverence and submission

6. Singing: Many Psalms, such as Psalm 100:1, call for joyful singing as an expression of worship, emphasizing the importance of music in praising God

These expressions can help us to learn humility, surrender, adoration and devotion. It's important to note that physical expressions should be appropriate for the context and should not be disruptive or distracting. While the Bible encourages physical expressions in worship, it's important to balance these expressions with other aspects of worship such as prayer, scripture reading and teaching
