## "The Mark of the Beast" Revelation 13

In the Clementine Recognitions II, 9, Simon Magus himself brags about his magical prowess, and specifically names animating statues as one of his abilities:

For I am able to render myself invisible to those who wish to lay hold of me, and again to be visible when I am willing to be seen. If I wish to flee, I can dig through the mountains, and pass through rocks as if they were clay. If I should throw myself headlong from a lofty mountain, I should be born unhurt to the earth, as if I were held up; when bound, I can loose myself, and bind those who had bound me; being shut up in prison, I can make the barriers open of their own accord; I can render statues animated so that those who see suppose that they are men. [https://theaeoneye.com/2014/10/21/the-simon-sancusconondrum/, cited 12-18-19]

Note: This is the same Simon Magus that Peter, John and Philip encountered in Acts 8:9ff, i.e. the \_\_\_\_\_\_

4. <sup>16</sup> It also forced all people, great and small, rich and poor, free and slave, to receive a \_\_\_\_\_\_ on their right hands or on their foreheads, <sup>17</sup> so that they could not buy or sell unless they had the mark, which is the name of the beast or the number of its name. (Rev. 13:16-17 NIV) Cp. Ezek. 9

- Note: It is important to note that the phrase says, "\_\_\_\_\_" not "\_\_\_\_\_," so the idea of some sort of RFID chip (Verichip) is outside of the biblical understanding and what John's audience would have expected. However, a \_\_\_\_\_\_ or some sort of permanent stamp like a UPC (1D code), or QR (matrix or 2D code) would fit the description culturally – now and then.

Question: What is the name or number? V. 18

Answer:

<u>value</u> is an alphanumeric <u>code</u> of assigning a <u>numerical</u> <u>value</u> to a name, word or phrase based on its letters. A single word can yield multiple values depending on the <u>cipher</u> used.

Gematria originated as an Assyro-Babylonian-Greek system of alphanumeric code or cipher that was later adopted into <u>Jewish culture</u>. Similar systems have been used in other languages and cultures: earlier, the Greek <u>isopsephy</u>, and later, derived from or inspired by Hebrew gematria, Arabic <u>abjad numerals</u>, and English gematria. <u>https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Gematria</u>, cited 12-19-19

Note: Many have tried to come up with the identity of this person but let us note at least three issues.

1. The number is not \_\_\_\_\_ - \_\_\_\_. It is 600, 60, and 6.

2. See 1 John 2:18, "<sup>18</sup> Dear children, this is the last hour; and as you have heard that the antichrist is coming, even now \_\_\_\_\_
